We offer the same high-quality support to families on the Isles of Scilly as we do throughout Cornwall.

Our helpline is open for parents and carers of children and young people with SEN (up to age 25) Tuesday to Friday, 10am-3pm.

If you reach us outside these hours, you're welcome to leave a message — we'll pick it up on the next working day and respond within five working days.

Whilst we don't provide face-to-face meetings on the Island, we are very happy to meet with you via Microsoft Teams, and we can also join meetings with your school or the local authority through Teams.

We visit the Isles of Scilly once a year, hosting parent drop-ins and coffee mornings so families can speak with us in person.

We also provide a range of training sessions for parents. If you'd like training delivered to a group, let us know — we can arrange an online Teams session at a time that works for everyone.
